## Last Week's Speaker: Anne Ferguson, Ph.D., Bay Area Older Adults Founder



## Bio

Anne manages Bay Area Older Adults' daily operations, long term strategy, finances, fundraising, and volunteers. To further advocate for Bay Area seniors, Anne was appointed as a member of the Aging Services Collaborative Leadership Council where she works with other organizations and individuals to provide leadership and build community-wide capacity to support, maintain, and promote the well-being of older adults and their caregivers in Santa Clara County.

In the first part of her career, Anne was awarded two pre-doctoral and two post-doctoral fellowship grants for cancer research and published 15 peer-reviewed scientific articles within five years.

Anne received her Ph.D. from UC San Diego, pursued her American Cancer Society postdoctoral fellowship to identify new breast tumor markers at The Johns Hopkins School of Medicine, and completed her M.B.A. at San Jose State University.
